On the 30th of March about 40 people made their way to Eggenburg near Vienna in Austria to spend one week together. Three Friends also attended the meeting online. Friends travelled from the UK, Ireland, the Netherlands, Georgia, Norway, Italy, Austria, Germany and Australia, creating a diverse and vibrant group.

The theme of Living Faithfully: *Self, Community, World* was the foundation of several discussions and it was interesting to reflect upon how the situation of *World* affects every *Self,* and how we can find hope and strength within our European and Middle East Young Friends Quaker Community. We were grateful to host Arne Springorum, a German Quaker climate activist from the Czech Republic, who shared his view on the ecological crisis, his activism, and motivation. As young people who are likely to bear witness to the long term effects of climate associated crises we had a difficult, yet honest, discussion about our feelings on the current reality of our world. In spite of feelings of disempowerment and of these heavier conversation subjects, we brainstormed how we could take action and how we could support those who already do.
